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Traumatic Brain Injury Experience:

Over a decade served as the Data Analysis and Management Center (DAMC)

Emmes served DAMC for a program of 3 US Department of Defense sponsored Phase II studies investigating the potential efficacy of hyperbaric oxygen for the treatment of post-concussive symptoms following mild traumatic brain injury.

Emmes provided full-scope support as the DAMC including protocol development; statistical design and analysis support; site management and monitoring; regulatory support; data management; pharmacovigilance, and electronic trial master file support.

Highlights Include:

- Extensive data management/warehousing effort:

 Development of data capture system to collect clinical data including modules for enrollment and randomization, specimen tracking, and electronic patient-reported outcomes; custom configuration for collection/management of data from external sources to include actigraph, EEG, and Holter heart monitor; integration with Picture Archiving and Communication System to house/manage DICOM images from complex MRI/CT protocol.
- Massive TLF generation effort for clinical study reports: Clinical study report for Phase II clinical trial contained 2200+ tables, listings and figures; Final statistical report for prospective longitudinal cohort study contained 1700+ tables, listings, and figure.
- **Vendor management:** Execution of NDAs and data use agreements for over 2 dozen subject matter experts.
- Manuscript/Presentation support: Co-authored more than 25 peer-reviewed manuscripts and more than 30 conference presentations to disseminate study findings to the scientific community.
